



1           **“A Resolution to Support the Addition of a Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion**  
2           **Component to the Core Curriculum”**

3       Whereas: TCU strives to educate its students to be global citizens who are culturally  
4           competent and ensure that every student feels accepted and included, and

5       Whereas: According to a survey by The Office of Institutional Research, students of color  
6           at TCU are less likely to feel comfortable, accepted, appreciated and a part of  
7           TCU, and

8       Whereas: According to the Intercultural Effectiveness Scale survey, graduates of TCU  
9           are less willing and able to interact with individuals from different  
10          backgrounds than when they arrived on campus, and

11       Whereas: TCU students are not currently required to take courses that provide  
12          engagement with diversity in our society, and

13       Whereas: This component can be added to the core curriculum without adding an  
14          additional course to a TCU student’s degree plan because it can be overlaid  
15          with other core and major requirements, and

16       Whereas: The implementation of the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion component in the  
17          core curriculum of TCU aims to make students more culturally competent and  
18          improve campus culture; therefore,

19       Let it be resolved by the House of Student Representatives at Texas Christian University:

20           (1) That the student body of Texas Christian University supports the implementation  
21           of a Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Component in the core curriculum.
